Description: This project consists of constructing a drainage collection system with underground piping and drainage inlets along SW 54th Place that ultimately ties into the Ivanhoe Canal east of Dykes Road.

Traffic Impacts: We understand the construction project is an inconvenience to people living and commuting in and around the area, so we greatly appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to complete construction and restoration as safely and quickly as possible.

Project Benefits: This project will ensure that SW 54th Place and Dykes Road are better protected from storm flooding. During significant storm events, stormwater runoff floods Dykes Road to stages that require temporary roadway closures. Constructing a stormwater conveyance system on SW 54th Place Right of Way to outfall into the Ivanhoe Canal will alleviate the flooding on Dykes Road and improve the service of the roadway during storm events.
