Call to order at 7:00 P.M. A quorum was established.

Aster Knight motioned to excuse the absences of the members listed above. Nancy Hartmann seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Debra Goff-Rose motioned to adopt the minutes for the two June meetings as presented. Aster Knight seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

The chair briefed the members present on the Calusa Corners Park improvements and the necessity of selecting durable playground equipment to be included within the procurement package for Staff to re bid the project. Staff provided details on the selection of a swingset, which can appeal to any age and provides a complete play experience as a standalone component. Staff also briefed the members regarding the playground and shade structure pricing, which will be included in the procurement

package as add/alternate items, in order to make the most efficient and cost-effective choices for those items that funding for the project will allow.

Aster Knight motioned to recommend selection of the proposed Playmore swingset with 2 bays/4 seats and the standard rectangular Appollo shade equipment. Marie Nix seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Color selections for the proposed equipment may be made at a later date.

The members present discussed items in the maintenance report. Staff was asked to explain the situation with maintenance over the I-75 overpass. This is an FDOT area of jurisdiction and the construction contractor is in charge of maintenance until the construction is complete.

John Herring suggested that Calusa Corners' theme should be a dog park. Dee Schroder commented that dog waste stations might be nice to have in parks.
