Broward JIC Snapshot #10: Eighth Vaccination Site Opens

KEY TAKEAWAYS

- DOH-Broward has provided 106,626 doses of COVID-19 vaccine at sites it manages in partnership with Broward County, Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO), municipalities, municipal law enforcement and Fire Rescue/EMS.
- DOH-Broward opened an eighth vaccination site on February 3, in partnership with Broward County Parks & Recreation and BSO. [The new site at Tree Tops Park in Davie will operate Sunday through Thursday from 8AM to 4PM.](#)
- Vista View Park vaccination site will close at the end of the day on Thursday, February 11, due to construction in the park. Anyone scheduled to receive their second dose of vaccine at Vista View Park on February 12 or later, should go to Tree Tops Park instead. Be sure to come for your second dose on the day written on your vaccination card and please bring your card with you.
- Florida Department of Emergency Management (FDEM) continues to offer vaccinations at houses of worship in underserved communities in Broward County. Vaccinations are being offered this week at five locations in Fort Lauderdale, Lauderdale Lakes and Miramar.

IMPORTANT REMINDER FOR THOSE WITH VACCINATION APPOINTMENTS

First dose appointments have a scheduled day and time. Second dose appointments generally only have a scheduled day. If you have an appointment for a scheduled day and time, please show up no more than 30 minutes ahead of time. First-dose appointments are scheduled throughout the day to ease traffic congestion and keep wait times at a minimum. Arriving at the site 30 minutes ahead of your appointment time helps reduce wait times for you, and for everyone else.

HOW TO GET VACCINATED

Eligible individuals are residents age 65+ and frontline healthcare workers, who can register for vaccine appointments online at myvaccine.fl.gov, or by calling 866-201-6313 (TTY 833-476-1526). Eligible individuals who register will be contacted when an appointment is available for them.
