

An Update from the Broward County COVID-19 JIC – March 17, 2021 Broward JIC Snapshot #17: Broward Sets Single-Day Vaccination Record

Department of Health in Broward (DOH-Broward) reported that Tuesday, March 16, set a new record for vaccinations in Broward County – 10,044 vaccinations were delivered in a single day, bringing the total number of persons vaccinated in Broward to 394,307.

As vaccine supplies increase, eligibility for vaccination is expanding. Broward County is now receiving quantities of all three available vaccines: Pfizer (two doses required); Moderna (two doses required) and Johnson & Johnson (one dose required). Here is a reminder of the many ways eligible residents are getting vaccinated.

DOH-Broward Sites

Florida Department of Health in Broward, in partnership with Broward County, municipal partners and BSO, is operating six drive-through vaccination sites and one walk-up, open to eligible residents. Appointments are required and can be made in the state's COVID-19 vaccine appointment scheduling system. Visit <u>myvaccine.fl.gov</u>, or call 866-201-6313 (TTY 833-476-1526). Eligible individuals will be contacted when an appointment is available for them.

- Central Broward Park & Broward County Stadium in Lauderhill (Drive-Through)
- Tree Tops Park in Davie (Drive-Through)
- Markham Park in Sunrise (Drive-Through)
- Coral Square Mall in Coral Springs (Walk-Up)

Florida Department of Emergency Management Sites

- FDEM in partnership with Broward Health and City of Fort Lauderdale are providing vaccine to eligible residents at Inter Miami CF Stadium at Lockhart Park in Fort Lauderdale.
- FDEM is offering an opportunity for homebound residents to register for vaccine in their home by emailing <u>homeboundvaccine@em.myflorida.com</u>.
- FDEM in partnership with the Regional Incident Management Team is providing vaccination in senior communities to individuals age 65 and older, and in houses of worship.
- FDEM is operating a walk-up vaccination site at Broward Community College North Campus in Coconut Creek to eligible residents.

Municipal Sites

Municipalities are providing vaccination to vulnerable seniors at 8 municipal "pop-up" sites, including the following cities: Davie, Fort Lauderdale, Lauderhill, Miramar, Oakland Park, Plantation, Pembroke Pines, and Wilton Manors. Additionally, Sunrise and Tamarac will have pop-ups operational on March 22, Hollywood on March 29 and Lighthouse Point on April 5.

Hospital Sites

Vaccination is being provided by hospital partners to eligible residents. **Schedule through a** <u>participating</u> <u>hospital</u>.
