As we look to the New Year, it is no secret that this is a time when it is good to have a new start and to look for ways to improve. We can do that in our own personal lives and I believe that we should also do that as a Town. I have been speaking with the administration on a couple of ideas for improvement and they are both centered around communication. Strong communication is always important. Even when you do it well, like I believe that our Town does most of the time, it is also something that can always be improved.

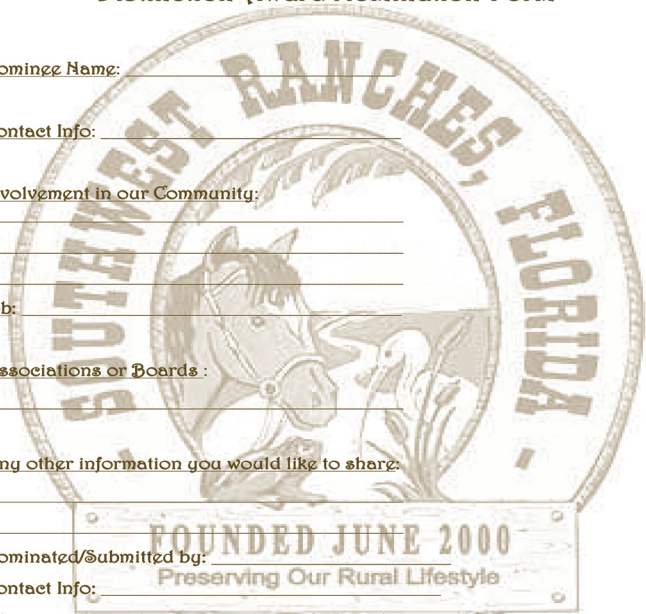

PROTOTYPE BARN



In furtherance of the Town's goal of preserving its rural lifestyle, the Town Council has given residents a simpler mechanism to build a barn that is in compliance with Florida statutory requirements. As such, the Town contracted with an architect who agreed to create a prototype barn drawing, in compliance with the Florida Building Code, which can be permitted for residents throughout the Town. The plans are for a three stall barn with a tack room.

A Town resident looking to build a barn can simply purchase a pre-drafted architectural plan from the Town, which they then can submit, at a reduced cost, and on an expedited basis, to get a permitted barn that will be in compliance with both state and local regulations.

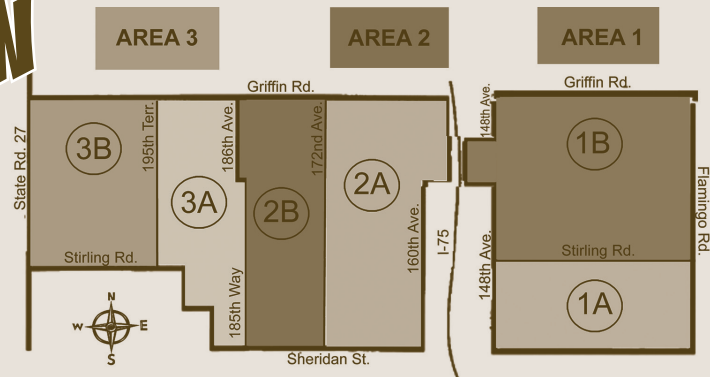

Register Now for Next CERT Training Class

The Davie Fire Rescue Department will be offering free training for the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). The next CERT training class is scheduled to begin on February 13, 2018. Anyone who lives or works in the Town of Davie or Southwest Ranches and is over 18 years old is eligible for the training classes. The class will meet at the Davie Fire Administration building located at 6901 Orange Drive. You must register before the class begins. Go to www.davie-fl.gov to download the CERT application.

The CERT program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training taught in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following an event when public safety personnel are not immediately available to help. CERT members also are encouraged to take a more active role in emergency preparedness projects in their community. By getting trained in CERT, you will have the skills to help emergency responders save lives and protect property.
